Once again we plan to gather for World Day of Prayer. Thank you to Ebenezer Presbyterian Church for hosting us on Saturday, March 8. Coffee is served at 9:30 and the prayer service begins at 10:00. Our purpose is to raise our collective voices in prayer and although it was at one time a women's day, that is no longer so. Everyone is encouraged to attend, so put it on your calendar and let us come together with believers from all around the world to pray.

The Guild ladies met on February 2 and finalized the plans for 2025. In March we will be holding a collection for the Foster care program that serves southeastern SD. The center is located at 14th St. and Avera Hospital on Cliff Ave and the sewing ladies have been making draw-string bags for children in transit so they have a way to carry their belongings. We ask you to donate full-sized personal care items. This might include shampoo, body wash, socks, toothbrushes, hairbrushes, for example. We also ask that you donate small suitcases and/or carry bags if possible. These must be new so as to assure that the distribution facility and contents are not "infected." The program sees upwards of 200 children per month and it is not uncommon for them to be moving to a foster home carrying little or nothing, so our gifts will be most welcome.

In August we plan to hold a collection for backpacks and school supplies as it is not unusual for children to be moving to attend a new school with no supplies. Thank you for your generosity.
